# Eco Club Annual Report (2025–2026)

## *Abstract*

The Eco Club of Government College Chowari carried out meaningful activities during the session 2025–2026 with the aim of promoting environmental awareness, health education, and responsible behaviour among students. Major activities included an AIDS Awareness Program and Campus Beautification and Cleanliness Drives. These initiatives encouraged active student participation and supported several Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

## *Introduction*

The Eco Club of Government College Chowari works to develop environmental awareness and a sense of responsibility among students. The club regularly organizes activities that focus on cleanliness, waste management, plantation, and social awareness.

During the academic session 2025–2026, the club conducted programs that combined awareness with practical learning. These activities helped students to understand real-life environmental issues and motivated them to take small but meaningful steps towards sustainability.

## *Brief Overview of Activities*

During the session, the Eco Club organized the following key activities:

- ✓ AIDS Awareness Program on World AIDS Day (1<sup>st</sup> December 2025)
- ✓ Campus Beautification Campaign (21<sup>st</sup> February 2026)
- ✓ Campus Cleanliness and Waste Segregation Drive (13<sup>th</sup> March 2026)

These activities focused on both awareness and action, helping students learn by doing.

## *Detailed Activities*

### **1. AIDS Awareness Program on World AIDS Day**

**Date:** 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2025

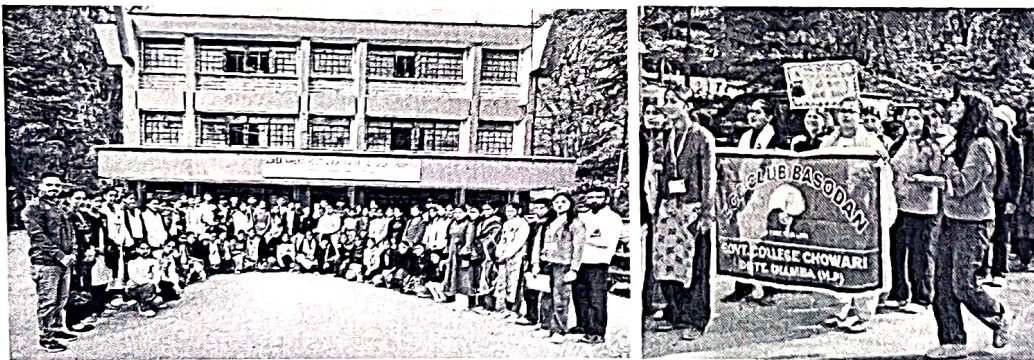
**Participants:** 73 (Eco Club & Red Ribbon Club Volunteers)

The Eco Club, in collaboration with the Red Ribbon Club, organized an awareness program on World AIDS Day. The program started with informative talks by Dr. Roop Lal and Prof. Pallavi Berry, who explained the causes, transmission, prevention, and common misconceptions related to AIDS in a simple and clear manner.

An awareness rally was then conducted from the college to the market and bus stand. Students raised slogans promoting an AIDS-free Bhattiyat and spread awareness among the general public. A street play performed by the students further helped in explaining the topic in an engaging and easy-to-understand way.

Date: 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2026

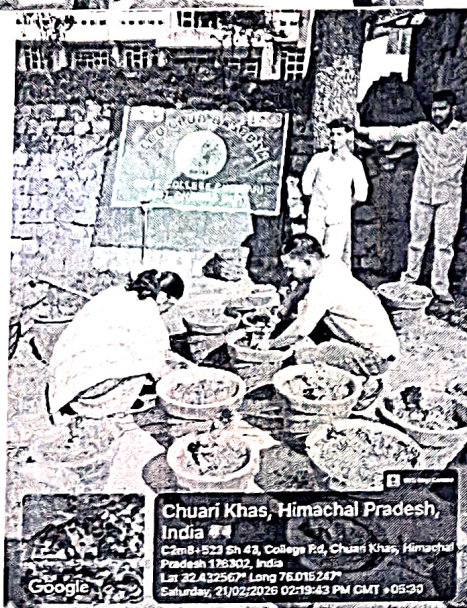
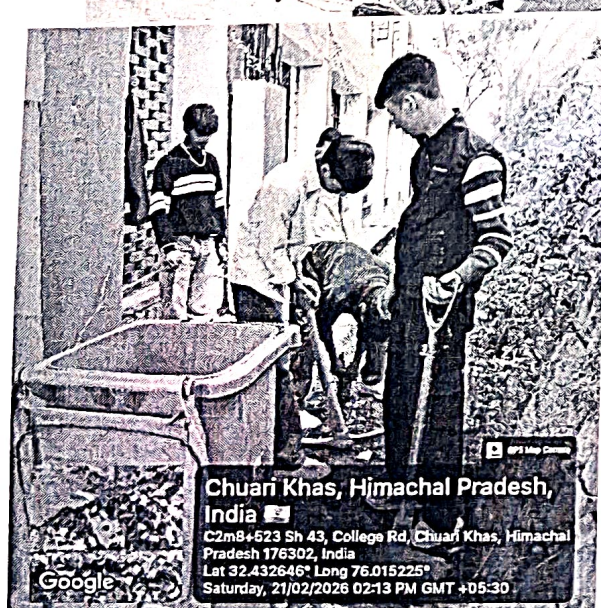
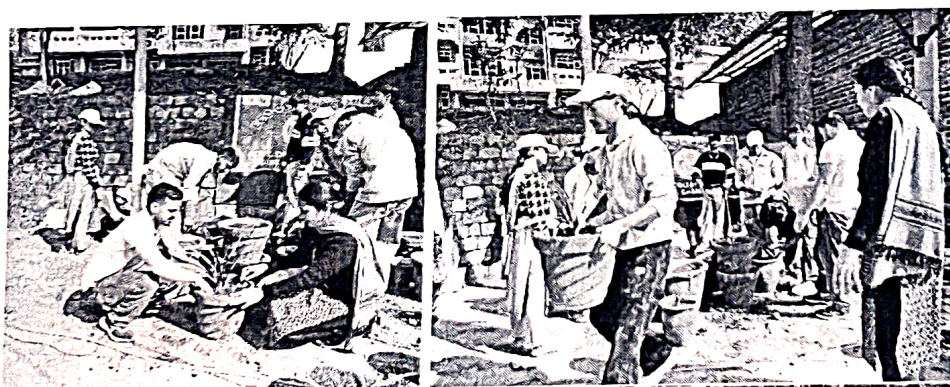
Participants: 16 Volunteers

The Eco Club organized a one-day Campus Beautification Campaign under the guidance of Principal Dr. Sanjay Singh Pathania. He encouraged students to take part in such activities and highlighted the importance of a clean and green environment.

During the activity, students prepared soil by mixing it with compost from the college composting unit. This mixture was used to fill pots, and ornamental plants were planted across the campus. The activity helped students learn about compost use, plant care, and maintaining green spaces.

### 3. Campus Cleanliness and Waste Segregation Drive

**Date:** 13<sup>th</sup> March, 2026

As part of the same campaign, students carried out a cleanliness and waste segregation activity. They separated waste into biodegradable (such as fallen leaves) and non-biodegradable (plastic) categories. The biodegradable waste was then added to the composting unit for conversion into organic manure.

This activity helped students understand the importance of waste segregation and its role in protecting the environment.

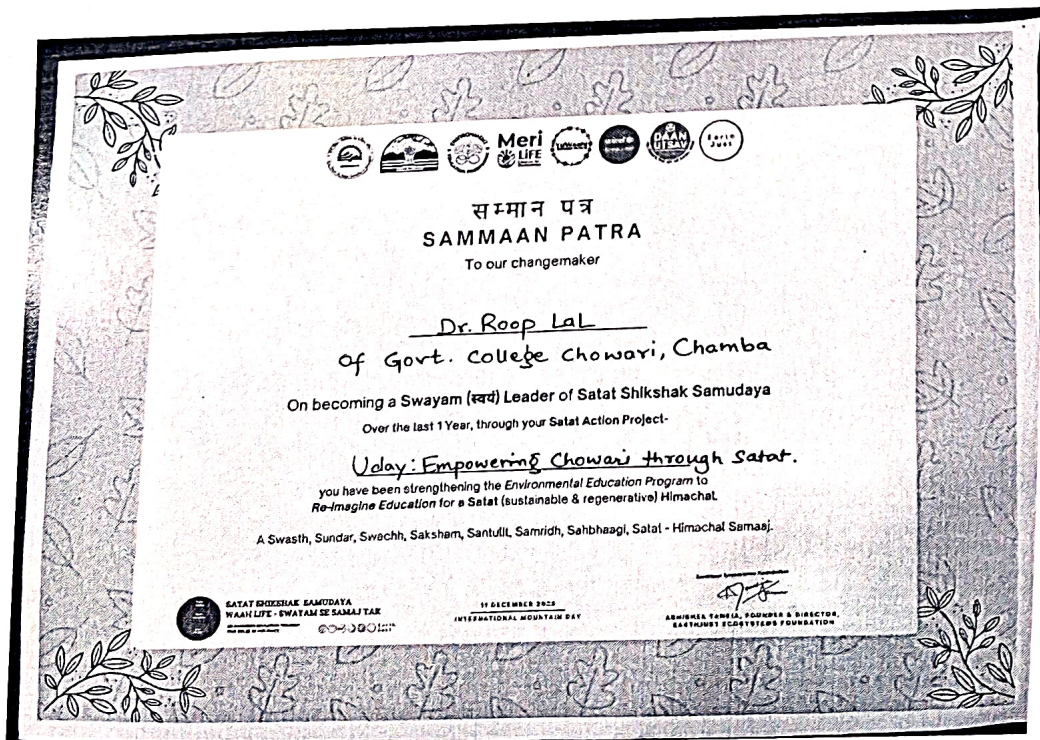
## Media Publication
