These students combined academic competence, creativity, and community involvement to support environmental stewardship.

4. Activities Undertaken

Brief Outline

a. Parthenium Weed Removal (03 Aug) - 17 volunteers removed toxic *Parthenium* weed near the canteen area, promoting native flora restoration.

b. Anti-Drug Awareness Campaign (12 Aug) - 25 volunteers led a rally and slogan drive to spread awareness against substance abuse.

c. Deodar Plantation Drive (21 Aug) - Collaboration with NSS; 25 volunteers have planted Deodar saplings.

d. Project UDAY - Communication and Awareness Rally (24–28 Aug) - Meeting and communication with local officials (SDM, Tehsildar, Nagar Panchayat officials) and citizens through awareness rallies on waste segregation and sustainable practices - 18 champions.

e. Field Survey on Waste Management (28–29 Aug) - 16 Eco Champions conducted surveys to gather data for Project UDAY.

f. Online Presentation – Communication Sprint (31 Aug) - Showcased Project UDAY on a digital platform to a state audience.

g. Decorative Pot Plantation Drive (04 Sept) – 19 volunteers planted 35 pots with ornamental plants for campus beautification and practical horticultural learning.

h. Waste Management Activity-Based Workshop (13 Sept) - Interactive session by Ashish Palyal with 21 volunteers, demonstrations at dumping site, role-play activities, and learnings about post collection of waste + collaboration with GSSS Hobar.

i. Bin Installation for Segregation (14 Sept) – 4 volunteers of Eco Club installed labelled floor-wise bins to promote waste segregation in campus.

j. Expert Talk on Ozone Layer Protection (16 Sept) - Lecture by Prof. Sidharth Sharma on Montreal Protocol and climate action. 113 students attended the lecture.

k. One-Day Tree Plantation Drive – Ek Ped Meri Maa Ke Naam (17 Sept) - Medicinal trees (Amla, Bahera, Arjuna) planted by 18 volunteers.

l. Swachhta Hi Seva Campaign Launch (18 Sept) - Cleaning, plastic waste segregation, rally planning aligned with Project UDAY.

m. Land and Water Cleanup near Shani Dev Temple (21 Sept) – 12 volunteers were actively involved in cleaning drive near temple and water reservoir for environmental and religious harmony.

n. Awareness Program at Govt. Girls Middle School (30 Sept) - Hands-on training in waste segregation for ~80 students by 5 eco club champions along with coordinator.

o. Awareness Program at Govt. Primary School (30 Sept) - Sensitization of primary school students (30 girls) under UDAY and SHS campaigns – executed by 5 champions along with coordinator.

p. Awareness Program at Himalayan Public School (01 Oct) - Hands-on training in waste segregation for 105 students, 7 teachers by 4 eco club champions.

q. Awareness Program at Rising Star Public School (01 Oct) - Hands-on training in waste segregation for 45 students, 4 teachers by 7 eco club champions.

r. Wildlife awareness quiz (07 Oct) – 150 students have participated in the quiz competition.

s. creativity corner - installation of wooden selfie point (16 Oct) – 12 volunteers have decorated a wooden selfie point made from reusable wooden material.

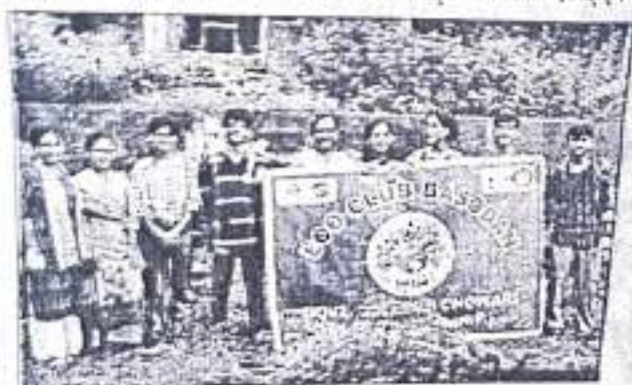

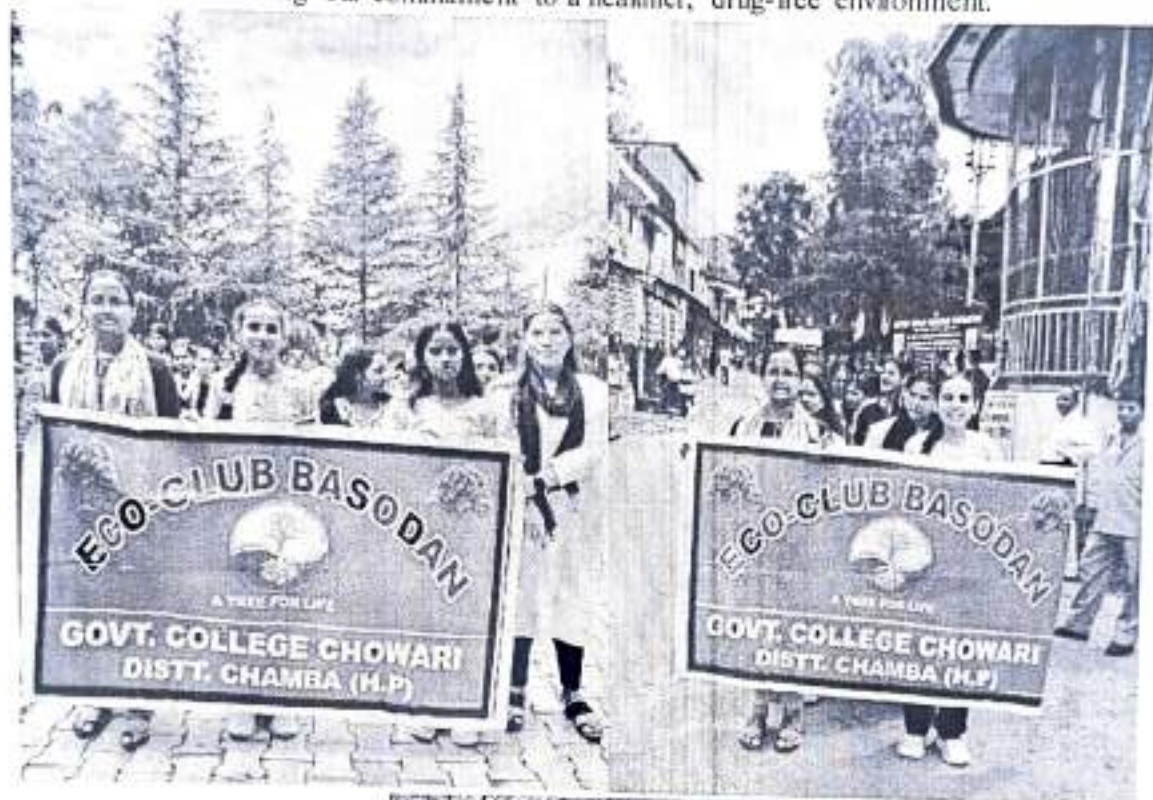

August 12, 2024

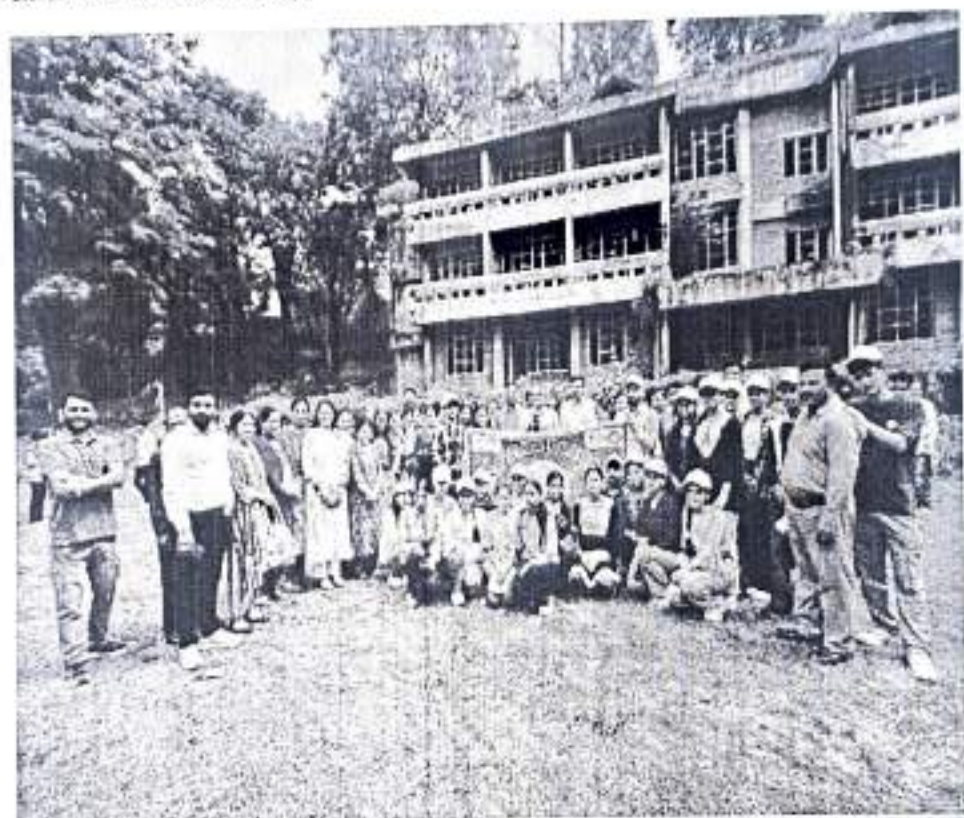

h. Eco Club Champions Ignite Awareness through Activity-Based Waste Management Campaign

13th September, 2024

The 21 bright students of the Eco Club at Government College Chowari gained special insights into the waste management system. This activity-based learning session was attended by Eco Club Coordinator Dr. Roop Lal, special guest speaker Mr. Ashish Palyal, five students from Government Senior Secondary School Hobar, and Eco Club Coordinator Mrs. Sangeeta. The session was conducted by the founder of Eco Science Foundation, Mr. Ashish Palyal.

Mr. Ashish Palyal provided students with fundamental knowledge of waste management through various activities, raising awareness about the problems of waste and its harmful consequences. Following this, the students visited a dumping site where they had the opportunity to understand the waste processing system. They learned about the functioning and operation of different machines, such as the organic waste converter and baling machine. The students also interacted with workers at the site to gain insight into the challenges faced during waste processing.

Additionally, during the activities, students took on roles as birds, cows, and monkeys to mimic their actions at the dumping site, helping them comprehend the importance of proper waste segregation. The special guest speaker informed the students about the health and environmental issues caused by waste and encouraged them to adopt positive steps.

In his address, Dr. Roop Lal provided information about the 'UDAY' project, an initiative by the Eco Club of Government College Chowari focused on waste management. He assured that they would successfully cultivate the habit of proper waste segregation and bring about a change in the perspectives of local people. He emphasized that the college would work together with the Municipal Council and local schools to achieve the project's goals.

At the conclusion of the program, Mr. Ashish Pahal praised the students' efforts and urged them to continue the noble practice of waste segregation and management. The Eco Club champions also interacted with the mini-champions from Hobar School, assuring them of all possible assistance.

j. Basodan Eco Club of Govt. College Chowari organizes Expert Talk and Discussion on World Ozone Day

16th September, 2024

On the occasion of Ozone Day, the Basodan Eco Club of Government College Chowari organized an informative lecture for the students on the critical topic of ozone protection and climate action. The event, held in the college, featured a lecture delivered by Mr. Sidharth Sharma, Associate Professor of Physics at Government College Chowari, titled "**Montreal Protocol: Advancing Climate Action**". The session began with a brief introduction by the Eco Club Coordinator, who shed light on major international agreements pivotal to environmental conservation, including the *Montreal Protocol*, the *Kyoto Protocol*, and the *Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD)*. These agreements have played a crucial role in addressing global environmental issues, particularly in reducing ozone depletion and mitigating climate change.

Following the introduction, Mr. Sidharth Sharma took the stage and delivered a comprehensive lecture. He started by explaining the basic concepts of ozone—its importance in shielding the Earth from harmful ultraviolet (UV) radiation—and the detrimental effects caused by **ozone-depleting substances (ODS)** such as chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs). Mr. Sharma highlighted **the adverse impacts of ODS on the environment**, including increased UV radiation leading to skin cancer, cataracts, and negative effects on marine life and ecosystems. A key aspect of the lecture was the discussion on the **Montreal Protocol**, a landmark international agreement aimed at phasing out the production and consumption of ODS. Mr. Sharma emphasized its **dual role** in not only combating ozone depletion but also in contributing to **climate action**, as many ODS are potent greenhouse gases. He explained how the success of the Montreal Protocol has set a precedent for international cooperation in addressing environmental challenges.

The event was attended by a **total of 113 students**, along with faculty members including Mr. Hans Raj, Mr. Balbir Singh, and Dr. Vishal Sharma. After the lecture, an interactive session was held, where students were encouraged to ask questions and share their key takeaways from the talk. The participants expressed their appreciation for the valuable insights gained about the environment, climate action, and global efforts in ozone protection.

The Ozone Day celebration was a resounding success, leaving students with a deeper understanding of environmental issues and inspiring them to contribute to climate action efforts in their own ways.

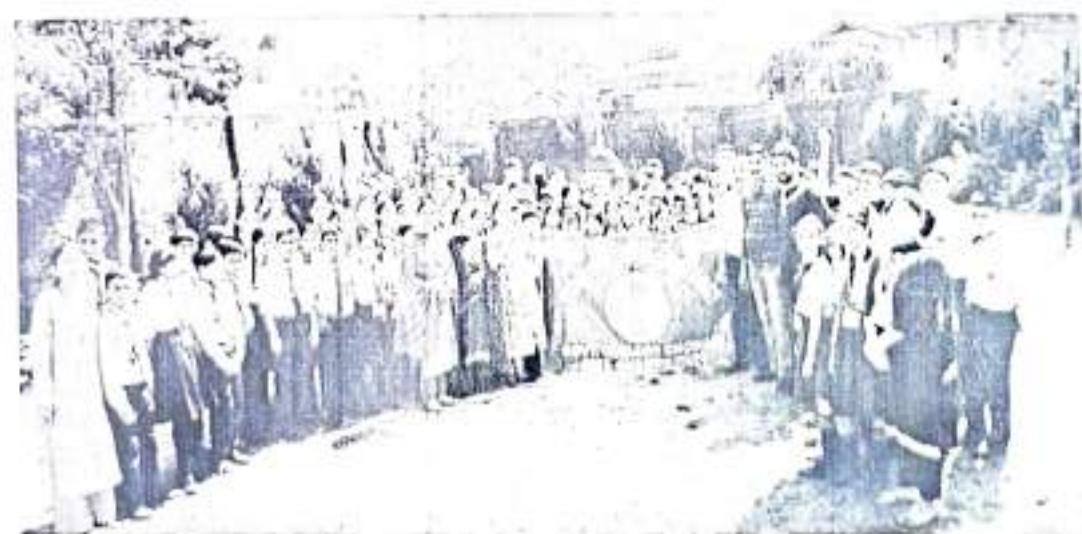
